MEMORANDUM FOR THE UNITED STATES

Petitioner contends (Pet. 2, 13) that a defendant is eligible for safety-valve relief under 18 U.S.C. 3553(f)(1) so long as he does not have every single one of the criminal-history factors specified in the subparagraphs of that provision. This Court granted certiorari in Pulsifer v. United States, 143 S. Ct. 978 (2023) (No. 22-340) (oral argument scheduled for Oct. 2, 2023), to consider whether that interpretation of Section 3553(f)(1) is correct. The petition for a writ of certiorari should therefore

be held pending the Court's decision in Pulsifer and then disposed of as appropriate in light of that decision.*
