MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED INFORMA PAUPERIS

COMES NOW Petitioner, Annamalai Annamalai, and pursuant to Rule 39, Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, moves this Court for an Order granting him leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

1) Petitioner was determined indigent by the district court, pursuant to Title 18 U.S.C. §3006A, and counsel was appointed to represent him on appeal before the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit.

2) Petitioner remains indigent and wishes to seek a writ of certiorari from this Court to the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit, which affirmed the judgment of the District Court on January 19, 2023.
