Dear Mr. Harris:

Petitioner Ohio State University filed its Petition for a Writ of Certiorari on March 14, 2023. On May 2, 2023, the Court requested that Respondents file a response, currently due June 1, 2023. Respondents respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a 29-day extension to and including June 30, 2023, within which to file their Brief in Opposition. Petitioner opposes this motion for an extension, which is Respondents' first.

The extension is requested due to the press of other matters. The undersigned has begun preparing the Brief in Opposition while attending to responsibilities in other cases, including a brief due in the Ninth Circuit on May 24, 2023. The requested extension is necessary, then, to ensure an adequate opportunity for Respondents' counsel to address the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari and *amicus* brief in light of other commitments.

The above-cited Petition is one of two Petitioner filed on the same day in related cases stemming out of the same facts and presenting an identical legal question. The other petition is *The Ohio State University v. Gonzales*, No. 22-897. The Court may want to consider the two petitions together, and Respondents in the *Gonzales* case will request extensions of a similar length.
