Dear Mr. Harris:

The purpose of this letter is to request a 30-day extension of Respondents George A. Camp, Jana R. Campbell, Helen M. Landers, Kenneth R. Marriott, Kolbee A. Perdue, Teri J. Robinson, Vi N. Wells, and Scotty D. York's deadline for filing a response to Ms. Carswell's petition for a writ of certiorari. Respondents' response is currently due on May 25, 2023. A 30-day extension of this deadline would fall on Saturday, June 24, 2023. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.1, when a deadline falls on a Saturday, the relevant period shall extend until the end of the next day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, federal legal holiday, or day on which the Court building is closed. Accordingly, should you grant Respondents' requested extension, their response to Ms. Carswell's petition for writ of certiorari will be due on Monday, June 26, 2023.

Respondents have not previously requested an extension of their deadline to file their response to Ms. Carswell's petition for writ of certiorari. This request is unopposed by Ms. Carswell.

Respondents seek this extension due to pre-existing commitments which require Respondents' counsel to be out of the office for several days in May as well as obligations in a variety of other matters pending before federal courts, including an amicus brief in support of petitions for writ of certiorari in this Court and dispositive motions in a case in the Western District of Texas.
