

Pursuant to this Court's rules 13.5, 21, 22, 30 and 33.2, Pro Se Petitioner, Dean Allen Steeves, respectfully requests a 60-day extension up to and including April 2, 2023 to file his Petition for a Writ of Certiorari re U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit Case No. 22-1079. Petitioner has attached the Circuit Court's judgment in

the case issued on July 21, 2022, as Exhibit “A”. Petitioner has also attached the Circuit Court’s denial of Petitioner’s Petition for a Panel Rehearing, dated November 2, 2022 as Exhibit “B”. Petitioner is invoking this Court’s jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. §1254(1) and the time to file a writ of certiorari, without an extension, will expire on February 2, 2023. Petitioner’s application is timely because Petitioner has filed his application for extension of time more than ten (10) days prior to the expiration date for filing.

REASONS FOR REQUESTING AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Petitioner suffered a serious injury a few months ago whereby His upper right jaw joint fractured and several teeth were broken. Complications regarding petitioner’s jaw movement have emerged and Petitioner may have to have a maxillofacial surgeon replace his jaw joint. In addition, petitioner is seeing an Orthodontist regarding a remedy for his multiple broken teeth. The timing to remedy the above could extend through the late summer of 2023.

Based upon the reasons above, which have severely interfered with Petitioner’s ability to provide a succinct and clearly expressed Petition for a Writ of Certiorari by February 2, 2023, Petitioner is requesting this Court to grant a 60-day extension up to and including April 2, 2022, to file his Petition for a Writ of Certiorari.
