## APPLICATION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE A PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

TO THE HONORABLE ELENA KAGAN, CIRCUIT JUSTICE FOR THE NINTH CIRCUIT:

Pursuant to Rules 13.5 and 30, petitioner David Shinn respectfully asks the Court for a 60-day extension of time, to and including April 7, 2023 to file a petition for a writ of certiorari in this matter.

The court of appeals issued a published opinion reversing the district court's denial of habeas corpus relief on June 28, 2021. (App. A.) See Jones v. Ryan, 1 F.4th 1179 (9th Cir. 2021). The court issued an amended opinion and denied a timely filed petition for rehearing on November 7, 2022. (App. B.) See Jones v. Ryan, 52 F.4th 1104 (9th Cir. 2022). This Court has jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. § 1254(1).

This extension is necessary due to the recent change in administration in the Office of the Arizona Attorney General. Attorney General Kris Mayes took office on June 2, 2023. And the office's new Solicitor General assumed his role on January 17, 2023. The extension of time is necessary to allow the Attorney General and Solicitor General time to review the case and have significant input in the petition for writ of certiorari. No prejudice will result to either party if this extension is granted. Counsel for Respondent does not object to this request.

Accordingly, Petitioner respectfully asks the Court to extend the time for filing a petition for writ of certiorari to and including April 7, 2023.
