Pursuant to Rule 33.2 (b), Petitioner Carlos Antonio Raymond, In the above-entitled case, respectfully moves for leave to file a 45-pages Petition For Writ Of Certiorari, which is due on June 19, 2023 ("60-days") from the date of the Court's letter, dated April 20, 2023. As grounds for this Application, Petitioner Carlos Antonio Raymond states:

1. Petitioner attempted to file a Petition For Writ Of Certiorari on January 13, 2023 and again on April 18, 2023, the papers was returned to Petitioner for the reason stated in the Court's recent letter, dated April 20, 2013.
2. Application for A Writ Of Certiorari is 45-pages that seeks to asserts claims of Frau (Fraudulent Misrepresentation, Fraud Of The Court and several others claims against Respondent, J. P. Morgan Chase Bank through its Attorney, Rachelle Hytkin.
3. The Petition further seeks to challenge the Evidence in support of Motion For Summary Judgment, filed and entered into the record of the United State District Court on May 28, 2021 and also with the Fifth Circuit Court Of Appeals On June 27, 2022.
4. The Record in both the Fifth Circuit and United States District Court contain a litany of Military Service-Connected disabling condition upon which Petitioner suffers.
