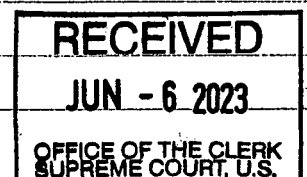
Appellant respectfully requests a 30

On approximately May 1st, 2023 I received notice from the MN Supreme Court that my petition for review of my criminal convictions was denied.

On Thursday May 4th; I was falsely accused of attempting to steal a book from the prison law library (exhibit A), and my access to the law library and my pleadings stored on the law library computers were taken from me until June 2nd.

The prison law library ^{staff} has stated the prison law library does not have the rules for petitioning this court for a writ of certiorari, and I am waiting for the State Law library to send me these rules.

Despite being vindicated of attempting to steal a book and my law library access supposedly restored (Exhibit B) - I have not yet as of this... day been given a pass to return to the law library.



Your kite should be directed to the staff who can best answer your question. If you send a kite requiring an answer to the wrong staff, it will be returned to you. Kites are to be used for offender to staff correspondence only. If your kite is not specific, and/or the top portion is not completely filled out, legible, and using your committed name, it will be returned for additional information. If you want your kite reviewed further up the chain of command, you must attach all previous kites to show the previous responses. Offender kite form 303.101A is used for general inquiries. Use kite form B for Health Services, Behavioral Health, and treatment inquiries.
