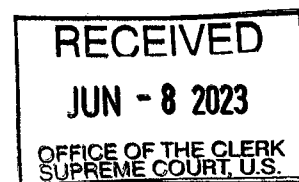
Re: Petition for a Writ of Certiorari in the Case of Gregory Kevin Samuels v. WMC Mortgage, LLC.


