Plaintiff-appellant Belkis R. Brito appeals from the district court's dismissal pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(6) of her complaint against Carrington Mortgage Services, LLC ("Carrington") asserting claims arising from an alleged wrongful foreclosure. The complaint essentially alleges that Carrington failed to comply with notice requirements that do not appear in the mortgage. We have carefully considered the parties' arguments and the record, and concur with the district court's conclusion that the allegations were insufficient to state any plausible claim that Carrington breached the terms of the mortgage or failed to comply with the conditions precedent to exercising the statutory power of sale under Mass. Gen. Laws c. 183, § 21. <u>Affirmed. See</u> 1st Cir. L. R. 27.0(c).
