TO THE HONORABLE ELENA KAGAN, CIRCUIT JUSTICE FOR THE
NINTH CIRCUIT:

Pursuant to Rules 13.5 and 30, petitioner Michael Jessup respectfully asks the Court for a 60-day extension of time, to and including October 24, 2022, to file a petition for a writ of certiorari in this matter.

The court of appeals issued a published opinion reversing the district court's grant of habeas corpus relief on April 21, 2022. (App. A) *See Jessup v. Shinn*, 31 F.4th 1262 (9th Cir. 2022). The court of appeals denied a timely filed petition for rehearing on May 27, 2022. (App. B) This Court's jurisdiction is invoked under 28 U.S.C. § 1254(1).

This extension is necessary to accommodate Mr. Jessup's counsel's other workload. Since the court of appeals denied rehearing in this case, counsel has filed (1) an opening brief in *Kristopher Dillon v. David Shinn*, No. 21-16181 (9th Cir.); (2) opening briefs in *James Parker v. State of Oklahoma*, No. PC-2022-527 (Okla. Crim. App.), and *Nawllah Tiger v. State of Oklahoma*, No. PC-2022-605 (Okla. Crim. App.); (3) a successive capital postconviction petition in *Tremane Wood v. State of Oklahoma*, No. PCD-2022-550; and (4) a reply brief in *Eulandas Flowers v. James Kimble*, No. 19-15116 (9th Cir.). Counsel

also has out-of-district, work-related travel scheduled for August 15–17, 2022, and has annual leave scheduled for August 4–8 and 18–19, 2022.

Accordingly, Mr. Jessup respectfully asks the Court to extend the time for filing a petition for certiorari to and including October 24, 2022.
