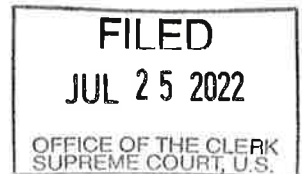

MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME PURSUANT TO RULE 13.5 TO FILE PETITIONER'S PRO SE PETITION FOR WRIT OR CERTIORARI TO THE COLORADO SUPREME COURT IN RE: COLE V EL PASO COUNTY

Now on this 12th day of August, 2022 A.D. comes pro se petitioner named-above and moves the Honorable Court for an Extension of Time pursuant to Rule 13.5. As grounds I provide as follows:

I. GROUND

A. Jurisdiction of the Court

1. On May 31st, 2022 the Colorado Supreme Court closed case 2022SC147 by an ORDER that denied Writ of Cert (see exhibit A attached hereto)

2. Multiple times thereafter I sought Rehearing (see exhibit B attached hereto)

3. Then within that court where on or about July 7th, 2022 the Court returned my paper seeking Rehearing to me with a register of action purporting the case was closed, thus no Rehearing would envoke. (see exhibit C attached hereto)

3. In the confusion I sought appointment of counsel herein this Court on or

about June 22nd, 2022 (see exhibit D attached hereto)

4. On or about August 2nd, 2022 I sought to enlarge time to petition for writ whereas this court provided me a rule book and papers relating to the method to obtain the sought relief (see Exhibit E attached hereto)

5. Jurisdiction is proper within this Court pursuant to Rule 10(b) or in alternate Rule 10(c)

B. Judgment Sought to be Reviewed

1. On or about May 11th, 2022 The Honorable Colorado Supreme Court tendered an ORDER within 2022SC147 to deny my petition for Writ of Certiorari (see exhibit A attached hereto)

2. Also see exhibit F attached hereto in regards to the Colorado Court of Appeals within 2022CA1392

C. Justification for Motion to Extend Time

1. Petitioner herein proceeds pro se and concurrently herewith moves the Court for leave to proceed as a poor person (see attached Motion for Leave to Proceed IN FORMA PAUPERIS)

2. Further, petitioner is an incarcerated individual where custodian, the above-named respondent, in attempt to preclude this filing, has failed to provide meaningful access to the courts, viz, failing to provide a law library with capabilities to print documents in accord to Rule 33.1(a) (see exhibit G attached hereto)

3. The aforementioned fettering could possibly be resolved where a pro-inmate sheriff deputy [REDACTED] is working with me to circumvent higher-ranking officials and print this foregoing

4. In the event we can complete this task and this foregoing is rendered to printed paper I also request upon the Court to provide as dicta within this sought ORDER to address the question pertaining to Rule 33.1(a), namely, may I hand write my Petition in the event I am not allowed to print a second time, or in alternate can the Court provide an ORDER to show cause why my custodian can not provide me with a means to print, or in alternate, use this Courts Injunctive power to enjoin respondent from causing on me further harm from the preclusion of filing papers herein by fettering same by failing to provide a means to print

WHEREFORE, undersigned petitioner prays this Honorable Court tender an ORDER providing

1. Petitioner may file a tardy petition within 60-days from this ORDER; and
2. As dicta, this Court further assert as to if petitioner must adhere to Rule 33.1(a) or can hand write the petition.

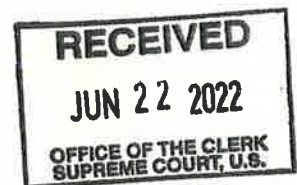

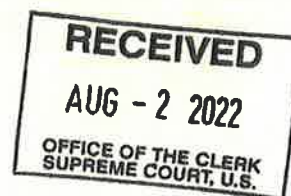
