II.

The present deadline for filing the Petition for Writ of  
Certiorari is November 04, 2022. Frazier has not requested

any extension prior to this request.

### III.

Petitioner Frazier's request for an extension is based upon the following facts:

Petitioner is currently incarcerated and due to extraordinary circumstances of access to legal material, aides, and resources, Petitioner should not be held to the same standards as a free world Attorney, Proceeding Pro-Se. Petitioner is an inexcusable layman to the law, and do apply the rules of the Court to the best of his ability, with resources available within current institution. Petitioner's request allows him to Shepardize cases in which are two days out due to having no access to internet and gives him reasonable resources to help locate case law to properly file Petition.
