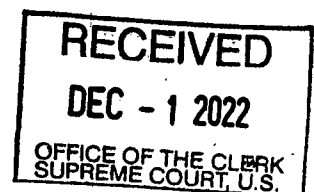

**APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PETITION
FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI TO THE UNITED STATES
CIRCUIT COURT OF APPEALS FOR THE ELEVENTH CIRCUIT**

**To the Honorable Justice Clarence Thomas, Associate Justice of the United
States Supreme Court and Circuit Justice for the Eleventh Circuit:**



Applicants Keith Jones and Florestine Jones, pursuant to the Rule of this Court respectfully requests an additional 30-day extension of time to file its petition for Writ of Certiorari. This request, if granted, would extend the deadline from November 30, 2022, to December 30, 2022.


The order of the Eleventh Circuit which is being appealed was entered on June 6, 2022 (attached as Exhibit 1). Jurisdiction of this Court to review the order and judgment of the Eleventh Circuit is being invoked pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1254(1).

The Petition for a Writ of Certiorari intends to address whether injunctive relief and indemnification should have been granted by the Eleventh Circuit. When other circuits held otherwise, and whether the District Courts impartiality might be reasonably questioned due to public notice of the bias in these type cases.

Applicants previously sought a 60-day extension of time to file this Writ of Certiorari due to recently suffered illness from covid19. This illness rendered them unable to secure timely counsel's help prior to the deadline to file the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari (and notably, after the Supreme Court Rule 13.5's 10-day extension window). Due to the difficult workload of the applicants preferred counsel for hire, time limitations have precluded them from securing counsel prior to the November 30, 2022 deadline to file the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari.

Applicants prayerfully seek this extension so that new counsel will have adequate time to fully research and evaluate the merits of this matter to draft a cogent and well researched Petition for a Writ of Certiorari.
