#### BY THE COURT:

Thomas Profetto has filed a motion for reconsideration, pursuant to 11th Cir. R. 22-1(c) and 27-2, of this Court's order dated September 29, 2022, denying his motion for a certificate of appealability and denying as moot his motion for leave to proceed on appeal *in forma pauperis*, in his appeal from the district court's denial of his *pro se* 28 U.S.C. § 2254 habeas corpus petition.
