To: Honorable Justice Gorsuch

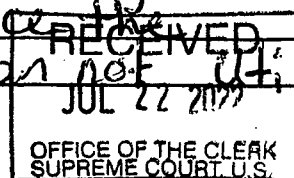
Marc Shipley, the Petitioner, in pro se, in necessity, hereby files his Application requesting an extension of time to file a Petition for a writ of Certiorari. Mr. Shipley relies on Rule 30 (3) as basis for his request. This Court should issue an order for Extension of time based on the following:

1) He is a pro se litigant with no legal training or experience.

2) He is an inmate confined in Federal Prison and has only limited access to legal resources.

3) His prison facility has limited access to the legal library to only 3 hours per week, due to COVID-19 restrictions still in place.

4) The law library has no restroom for handicap use, further restricting the use of the law library. Since the petitioner is handicap, and can not utilize

the stairs.

5.) Petitioner is also waiting for the District Court to correct errors in the record that are necessary, in order for this court to rule properly on petitioner's writ of Certiorari.

6.) This motion is made in the interest of justice and not meant to delay the proceedings.

Wherefore based on the above Mr. Shipley moves this Court to grant his motion and asks this Court to issue an order granting a 90 day extension of time, for a total of 180 days to file initial writ of Certiorari.
