ORDER

On consideration of the papers filed in this appeal and review of the short record,

IT IS ORDERED that this appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction.

The order appealed from is not a final appealable judgment within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. § 1291. In its order of May 31, 2022 – the order appellant Tolbert appeals – the district court explicitly stated that “Plaintiff’s Complaint may proceed.” There was clearly no final determination of plaintiff George Tolbert’s claims at the time plaintiff Tolbert filed his notice of appeal, and no other basis to exercise appellate jurisdiction is apparent.
