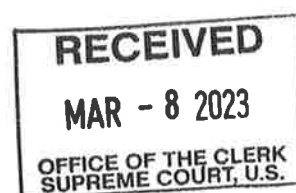
 MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME ON PETITION
