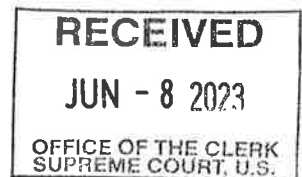


MOTION TO CONTINUE EXTENSION OF TIME
