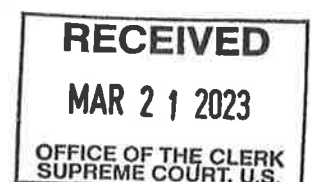
REASONS JUSTIFYING AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Pursuant to rule 13.5 of the Rules of this Court, Applicant Lindsay Lee hereby requests a 60 day or maximum time extension to file a petition for the following good cause reasons:

1. I need more time to find an attorney or prepare a writ of certiorari pro se. I do not have legal expertise or experience in preparing legal documents. I need time for research and review in order to become familiar with and to understand legal terms and court procedures for writing a writ of certiorari. I was not made aware of the lower court decision until much later by my attorney. I was then notified that my attorney in New York does not handle US Supreme Court matters and would take no further action on my behalf.
2. I have medical and health conditions that I am currently dealing with. I am having a major surgery on March 31, 2023 in which I will need recovery time.
3. I am a student. I am enrolled full-time in an accelerated degree program. Therefore, I need more time in order to continue my studies while undergoing reasons one and two.

JURISDICTION

This Court has jurisdiction. The New York Court of Appeals order denying leave was rendered on December 28, 2022. Provided is a copy of the lower Court order.
