ORDER DENYING MOTION TO STAY AND SETTING SELF SURRENDER DATE

THIS CAUSE came before the Court for a Telephonic Status Conference on February 16, 2023 [ECF No. 74] (“Status Conference”). At the Status Conference, Defendant made an *ore tenus* motion to stay (“Motion to Stay”) the Court’s Order Sustaining the United States’ Objection to the Magistrate Judge’s Order Regarding Competency [ECF No. 72] (“Order”) for the duration of Defendant’s appeal of the Order. *See* Notice of Appeal [ECF No. 73]. The Court having heard argument on the Motion to Stay and being otherwise fully advised, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Defendant’s Motion to Stay is **DENIED** for the reasons stated on the record at the Status Conference. Defendant is hereby **ORDERED** to self-surrender to Butner Federal Medical Center on **April 25, 2023 by 5:00 p.m. eastern standard time**. Furthermore, the day prior to Defendant surrendering to Butner Federal Medical Center, the United States Probation Office shall remove Defendant’s ankle monitor to allow him to travel.

Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(1)(A), the delay resulting from any prior or forthcoming examinations to determine Defendant’s competency shall be excluded from the time within which the trial of any offense in this case must commence.
