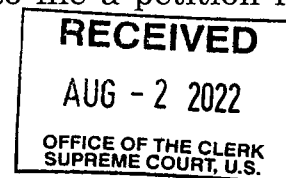
**INTRODUCTION**

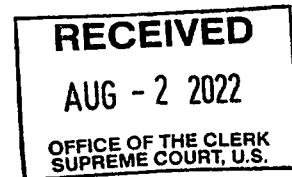
