

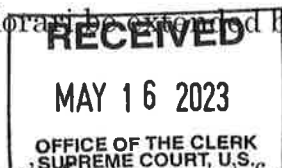

Dear Judge Roberts,

I am the pro se petitioner in the above mentioned civil rights case against the University of Arizona d/b/a Arizona Board of Regents, Southern Arizona Veterans Administration Health Care System, Davis-Monthan Air Force Base/United States Air Force, Banner University Medical Center – South Campus, and Genoa Healthcare, LLC. According to the online docket and pursuant to Rule 13.1 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, the writ of certiorari is due on May 24, 2023. Pursuant to Rule 30.3, petitioner respectfully requests that the time for filing said writ of certiorari be extended by 60 days, to and including July 23, 2023.



This is the petitioner's first request for an extension of time to file the writ of certiorari. Good cause exists for the requested extension. First, petitioner does not

have a home computer which requires her to utilize limited public resources for access to documents and technology which has delayed progress towards completion. Second, as a pro se litigant, petitioner has more limited knowledge of legal procedures, protocol, and language which requires more time to complete any documentation/filings. Finally, petitioner is in the process of getting an attorney to represent her in these proceedings and needs the extra time for the transfer of the case.

Accordingly, petitioner respectfully requests that the time for filing the petition for writ of certiorari be extended by 60 days, to and including July 23, 2023. Counsel for the respondents are being notified of said request.
