

DIRECTIONS TO THE CLERK

Per Rules of the United States Supreme Court 13.5 & 30.4, Petitioner respectfully requests that an extension of 60 days be granted and factored in from the due date of July 13, 2022 to make the petition for Writ of Certiorari timely. As such, Petitioner requests that the Clerk of this Honorable Court file the petition out of time considering the following factors.

- 1) An application for an extension of time within which to file a petition for a Writ of Certiorari in the above-entitled Case was postmarked October 3, 2022 and received October 12, 2022 by this Honorable Court.
- 2) It was returned for being out of time, however the Clerk of the Court stated in its response dated October 12, 2022 that if I was seeking to file the petition for a Writ of Certiorari out of time, I should submit the petition with a Motion to direct the Clerk to file the petition out of time.



- 3) On page 7 of the petition, there is a footnote of jurisdiction explaining the reasons why petitioner's 90-day window for the timely filing of this petition for a Writ of Certiorari was delayed.
- 4) During the time that the lower Court's judgment or order denying a timely petition for rehearing was April 14, 2022 and the subsequent 90-day window due date of July 13, 2022 Petitioner experienced a FDC department needs transfer between institutions on June 1, 2022 and the subsequent covid-19 quarantine for 14 days, deprived Petitioner's access to the Law Library, research materials, Law Clerk assistance and the delivery of his active legal materials box from the previous institution, Dade Correctional Institution.

These are extraordinary circumstances beyond the control of Petitioner and with good cause; Petitioner prays that the specific reasons mentioned above allow the Clerk to file the petition out of time.
