Dear Mr. Harris:

Respondent Ron Neal respectfully requests a 60-day extension of time in which to file his response to the petition for certiorari in the above-captioned case. The Court requested a response to the petition on April 17, 2024. The response is currently due May 17, 2024, and with a 60-day extension, the response would be due on July 16, 2024. This extension is necessary because counsel, who did not represent the respondent below, is heavily engaged with the press of other matters, including a three-day bench trial in May.<sup>1</sup> Counsel has not previously requested an extension.
