This photo was taken in January of 2024 next to Arcade Creek in the City of Sacramento, during an assessment of environmental issues that arise when winter rainfall causes the creek to rise and flood the various encampments next to it. The shelter on the left is suspended approximately three to four feet off the ground and comprised of a wooden floor, four walls, and a top cover within the branches of a tree. Because this structure is suspended off of the ground, it can withstand seasonal changes in the river's water level.





This photo was taken in the summer of 2023. It depicts an encampment located near 2nd and R streets in the City of Sacramento. Sacramentans who live and work nearby report that this encampment began in March of 2020 and subsequently expanded to the size depicted in the photo.





This photo depicts a recreational vehicle parked along River Plaza Drive in the City of Sacramento in December of 2023. A local resident reports that the RV is being utilized for shelter and has been parked along this street since 2018.





This photo depicts an encampment with several residents in the City of Sacramento in 2023. The residents utilizing these structures for shelter have run extension cords to the City of Sacramento's power grid for electricity.
