Dear Mr. Bickell:

I write to enter my appearance as counsel of record for the respondents and to request a thirty-day extension of the time to file a response to the petition for certiorari in this case. The response is currently due on October 13, 2023, and I respectfully request that the deadline be extended to, and include, November 13, 2023.

There is good cause for this request. My firm has just recently been retained in this case, and my colleagues and I have several deadlines in the upcoming weeks that would make it impossible to prepare a brief absent an extension, including an oral argument in this Court. These deadlines include a consolidated oral argument in the Eleventh Circuit in Holden v. Holiday Inn and Mayer v. Holiday Inn on October 3; a response brief in the California Court of Appeal in Valdovinos v. Kia on October 3; a reply in support of a motion for final approval in the District Court for the District of Columbia in NVLSP v. United States on October 3; an answering brief in the Ninth Circuit in Johnson v. Nissan on October 4; an oral argument in the Ninth Circuit in Anderson v. Intel on October 5; an oral argument in the Eleventh Circuit in Louis v. Bluegreen on October 6; a response brief in the Washington Court of Appeals in Long v. Monsanto on October 6; a reply brief in the Fifth Circuit in Ethridge v. Samsung on October 6; an answer to a petition for review in the California Supreme Court in Kielar v. Superior Court on October 11; an oral argument in the Washington Supreme Court in Nwauzor v. GEO on October 17; a consolidated oral argument in the Sixth Circuit in Bradford v. Team Pizza and Parker v. Battle Creek Pizza on October 18; an oral argument in the Fourth Circuit in Mohamed v. Bank of America on October 24; an oral argument in the Fourth Circuit in Fernandez v. Rentgrow on October 26; and an oral argument in this Court in Vidal v. Elster on November 1.

For these reasons, my colleagues and I will require additional time to prepare an adequate response to the petition. A thirty-day extension will allow us to balance these other responsibilities with our obligations in this case.
