Dear Mr. Harris:

On September 12, 2023 the Court docketed the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari and called for a response on October 12, 2023 in each of the abovereferenced cases. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, Respondents request a 28day extension to file a consolidated brief in opposition, to and including November 9, 2023.

Counsel for Respondents seek an extension of time in which to file their brief in opposition due to the fact they will be responding to petitions for certiorari in each of the cases referenced and because of the press of other litigation deadlines. Counsel has the following deadlines in the weeks leading up to and immediately following the current deadline:

- An opening brief on September 25, 2023 in *L.M. Town of Middleborough*, U.S. Court of Appeals for the First Circuit, No. 23-1535;
- An amicus brief on September 26, 2023 in *Volokh v. James*, U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit, No. 23-356;
- An amicus brief on October 2, 2023 in *Parents Defending Education v. Olentangy Local School District*, U.S. Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit, No. 23-3630
- An amicus brief on October 5, 2023 in *Finney v. Missouri Department* of *Corrections*, U.S. Supreme Court, No. 23-203;

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- A supplemental reply brief on October 13, 2023 in *Kerr v. Planned Parenthood South Atlantic*, U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit, No. 21-1043;
- An opening brief on October 18, 2023 in *Christian Healthcare Centers v. Nessel*, U.S. Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit, No. 23-1769; and
- An amicus brief on October 18, 2023 in *SEC v. Jarkesy*, U.S. Supreme Court, No. 22-859.

Counsel for Danco Laboratories consent to the requested extension and counsel for U.S. Food and Drug Administration indicated they do not oppose the request.

For these reasons, Respondents respectfully request that the time in which to file their brief in opposition in these matters be extended for 28 days to November 9, 2023.
