Dear Mr. Harris:

The Court docketed the petition in the above-referenced case on September 28, 2023. Responses are currently due on October 30, 2023. In accordance with Supreme Court Rules 15.3 and 30.4, Respondents Flint Hills Resources, LLC and Flint Hills Resources Alaska, LLC (collectively, “Flint Hills”) respectfully request a thirty-day extension of time, up to and including November 29, 2023, to file their brief in opposition.¹ Flint Hills understands that Respondent the State of Alaska plans to seek a corresponding extension.

The extension of time is warranted because undersigned counsel is newly representing Flint Hills in this Court and has significant pre-existing commitments. The extension will allow sufficient time to review the record and prepare a brief in opposition that will best assist the Court.
