Respondent City of Seattle respectfully requests a one-month extension to and including December 15, 2023, to file its opposition to the petition for certiorari. *See* Rule 30.4.

After obtaining an extension, Petitioners filed their petition on September 26. After the City waived its right to respond, the Court requested the City's response on October 12, setting a deadline of November 13.

Petitioners' counsel of record does not oppose this request, which the City makes because the City's counsel of record is engaged with the press of other litigation and client needs. The extension should also enable the City to prepare a coordinated response to the briefing likely to be filed by *amici curiae*, five of whom have already notified the City of their intent to file. Briefs of *amici curiae* are due November 13. *See* Rule 37.2(a).
