**MOTION TO DISMISS
PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI PURSUANT TO RULE 46.2**

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 46.2, petitioners BP America Production Company, Hilcorp Energy Company, and Shell Oil Company respectfully request that this case be dismissed and that all costs incurred in this case be assessed against the party incurring such costs. Respondents Parish of Cameron, Louisiana; State of Louisiana, ex rel. Jeff Landry, Attorney General; and State of Louisiana, through the Natural Resources Office of Coastal Management and its Secretary Thomas H. Harris, have agreed to dismiss this case under Supreme Court Rule 46.2 with all costs incurred to the party incurring the costs.

Respondents Chevron U.S.A., Inc., Texas Pacific Oil Company, Inc., and Texas Petroleum Investment Company did not respond to petitioners' request to stipulate to dismissal. Texas Pacific Oil Company, Inc. filed a Waiver in response to the certiorari petition; neither Chevron U.S.A., Inc. nor Texas Petroleum Investment Company responded to the certiorari petition. All three entities were co-defendants with petitioners in the proceedings below. Out of an abundance of caution, petitioners file this motion under Rule 46.2.


