Dear Mr. Bickell:

I am counsel for respondents in the above-referenced case. On October 19, 2023, a certiorari petition was filed in this case, and on November 7, 2023, the Court requested a response. Unless extended by the Court, the response is due on December 7, 2023. For the reasons that follow, and pursuant to Rule 30.4, I respectfully request an extension of 30-days, to and including January 8, 2024, to file a response.

In addition to the upcoming holidays, I have several pressing obligations during these next few weeks, including a pre-trial conference on November 28<sup>th</sup> and trial preparation with clients and staff for a two-phase representative wage and hour trial beginning on December 12 (scheduled for approximately 3-5 days) and subsequent law and motion work. For the clerk's reference, the case is in the Central District of California titled *Willie Williams et al v. J.B. Hunt Transport, Inc.*, Case No. 20-cv-01701-PSG-JDE.
