The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on July 24, 2023. The government's response is now due, after two extensions, on October 25, 2023. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including December 1, 2023 within which to file a response.
