COMES NOW, Petitioner Cornelius Michael Turner, by his attorney, Clyde M. Collins, Jr., and moves this Honorable Court, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1915, 18 U.S.C. §3006A(d)(6) and Sup. Ct. R. 39.1 and .2, for leave to file a Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals without prepayment of docket or other fees, and to proceed In Forma Pauperis. The petition accompanies this Motion.

On February 14, 2021, United States Magistrate James R. Klindt appointed undersigned counsel to represent Mr. Turner pursuant to the Criminal Justice Act. Following Mr. Turner's plea, he appealed his sentence of one hundred eighty months of imprisonment. On appeal, undersigned counsel continued to represent Mr. Turner without payment of fees or costs or security and without filing the affidavit required by U.S. §1915(a), all pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §3006A(d)(6).

As both the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida and the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit permitted Mr. Turner to proceed In Forma Pauperis and appointed counsel for him, no affidavit in support of this Motion to Proceed In Forma Pauperis in this Court is required. 18 U.S.C. §3006A(d)(6) and Sup. Ct. R. 39.1
