**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED
IN FORMA PAUPERIS**

TO THE HONORABLE JUSTICES OF SAID COURT:

COMES NOW the Petitioner, JULIAN BREAL, by and through his undersigned counsel and hereby moves this Honorable Court to allow him to proceed in forma pauperis, pursuant to Rule 39, Supreme Court Rules, and pursuant to the Criminal Justice Act of 1964, 18 U.S.C. Section 3006(a), and as

grounds therefore would state as follows:

1. The Petitioner seeks leave to file, in forma pauperis, a Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit, seeking review of said Court's Order Affirming Denial of Petitioner's Motion to Vacate Sentence pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §2255.

2. The Petitioner was convicted in the District Court for conspiracy to commit hostage taking; substantive hostage taking; kidnapping; carjacking resulting in bodily injury; and possession of a firearm in furtherance of a crime of violence. The Petitioner was sentenced to a term of imprisonment of 50 years which he is currently serving.

3. Undersigned counsel was appointed pursuant to the Criminal Justice Act of 1964, 18 U.S.C. Section 3006(a) to represent the Petitioner in the District Court as well as on appeal in the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit.

4. Pursuant to Rule 39, Supreme Court Rules, the Petitioner respectfully prays this Court allow him to proceed in formal pauperis. The Petitioner has not sought to proceed in forma pauperis prior to this petition.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Petitioner, JULIAN BREAL, by and through his attorney of record, respectfully requests the Court to grant this his Motion for Leave to Proceed in Forma Pauperis before this Honorable Court.
