APPLICATION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Pursuant to Rule 13.5 of the Rules of this Court, Petitioners Jenny Schieber, Solange Faktor, Esther Gutrejman, Louis Schneider, and Simon Bywalski hereby request a 30-day extension of time within which to file a petition for a writ of certiorari up to and including Wednesday, November 15, 2023.

JUDGMENT FOR WHICH REVIEW IS SOUGHT

The judgment for which review is sought *Schieber v. United States*, 77 F.4th 806 (D.C. Cir. 2023). (attached as Exhibit 1).

JURISDICTION

This Court will have jurisdiction over any timely filed petition for certiorari in this case pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1254(1). Under Rules 13.1, 13.3, and 30.1 of the Rules of this Court, a petition for a writ of certiorari was due to be filed on or before October 16, 2023. In accordance with Rule 13.5, this application is being filed more than 10 days in advance of the filing date for the petition for a writ of certiorari.

REASONS JUSTIFYING AN EXTENSION OF TIME

1. Counsel for petitioners are orthodox Jews and, as such, they strictly observe the high holiday season between September 14, 2023 until October 7, 2023 (Rosh HaShana [Jewish New Year], Yom Kippur; and Sukkot [Feast of Tabernacles]).
2. This schedule prevents counsel from devoting sufficient amount of time necessary to conduct adequate research and to prepare a petition that will be of maximum assistance to the Court.
3. Accordingly, counsel requests a 30-day extension to November 15, 2023.
