No motion for rehearing or reinstatement will be entertained by the Court.

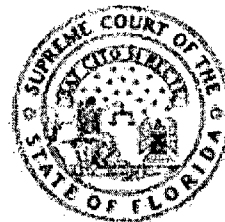

ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS RELIEF

THIS MATTER is before the Court on Defendant's "petition for writ of habeas corpus relief" filed on June 21, 2022, pursuant to Florida Rule of Criminal Procedure 3.850. After reviewing Defendant's petition, the court file, and the record, the Court finds as follows:

In case 02-CF-014739, on September 17, 2003, Defendant pleaded guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to murder in the first degree (count one) (*See* plea form, attached). The Court sentenced him to life in prison without parole on count one. (*See* judgment and sentence, attached). Defendant did not appeal the judgment or sentence.

In his petition, Defendant requests that the Court allow him to file a belated rule 3.850 motion in this case. He alleges that he was never given a competency hearing as required under Rule 3.212(b), and therefore, he is entitled to file a belated rule 3.850 motion due to the Court's fundamental procedural defect that voided its jurisdiction to adjudicate him.

After reviewing the petition, the court file, and the record, the Court finds that Defendant is not entitled to the requested relief. The Court further finds that Defendant's claim that the Court failed to conduct a competency hearing should have been raised, if at all, on direct appeal of the judgment and sentence. *See* Fla. R. Crim. P. 3.850(c) (2022) ("This rule does not authorize relief based on grounds that could have or should have been raised at trial and, if

properly preserved, on direct appeal of the judgment and sentence.”). As such, no relief is warranted.

It is therefore **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that Defendant’s “petition for writ of habeas corpus relief” is hereby **DENIED**.

Defendant has thirty (30) days from the date of this Final Order within which to appeal. However, a timely-filed motion for rehearing shall toll the finality of this Order.
