

TO THE HONORABLE COURT; COMES NOW the Petitioner, Mark Anthony Thompson, acting on his own behalf before this Honorable Court respectfully requests to proceed in forma pauperis, pursuant to the Rule 29.1 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States.

The undersigned understands that this appointment exempts the petitioner from payment of fees or cost, and from the filing of affidavit pursuant to 28 U.S.C. section 1915 (a).
