MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED
IN FORMA PAUPERIS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that petitioner, Kareem Davis, respectfully moves for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* in connection with the above-captioned petition for a writ of *certiorari*. Mr. Davis was granted leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* in the underlying proceedings in the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit and the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York. Bruce D.
