## MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Kennath Henderson, the petitioner, seeks leave, pursuant to Sup. Ct. R. 39, to contemporaneously file a petition for a writ of certiorari without payment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis* without prepayment of fees.

Mr. Henderson is an indigent Tennessee death row inmate. State v. Henderson 24 S.W.3d 307 (Tenn. 2000). The district court found Mr. Henderson to be indigent and entitled to appointment of counsel pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3599 and 21 U.S.C. § 848, and the Federal Public Defender for the Middle District of Tennessee was appointed to represent him.
