Before the panel of Randolph, C.J., Coleman and Griffis, JJ., is the Application for Leave to Proceed in the Trial Court filed by Joshua Anthony Peterman. The panel finds that Peterman's application to file a motion for post-conviction relief, his third, is time-barred and barred as a successive writ. Miss. Code Ann. §§ 99-39-5(2),-27(9). After due consideration, the panel finds that Peterman's application should be denied.

The panel finds that the instant filing is frivolous. Peterman hereby is warned that future filings deemed frivolous may result not only in monetary sanctions but also in restrictions on filing applications for post-conviction collateral relief (or pleadings in that nature) in forma pauperis. Order, *Dunn v. State*, 2016-M-01514 (Miss. Nov. 15, 2018).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Application for Leave to Proceed in the Trial Court filed by Joshua Anthony Peterman is denied.
