


Dear Mr. Harris:

Please consider the enclosed amended Motion for Leave to Proceed In Forma Pauperis which was dated December 4, 2023, and filed with the Court and placed on the docket on December 7, 2023 as No. 23-6197. The original Motion was incorrect and submitted in error. I would like to correct the record and request that you reconsider the amended Motion. 
The petitioner asks leave to file the attached petition for a writ of certiorari without prepayment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*.


