Affidavit in support of notice for leave to proceed in forma pauperis

I, JéVon-Montell Hollowell, American Indian, Sovereign, am the plaintiff in this matter. In support of my notice to proceed in forma pauperis, I state that because of my impecunious state, I am unable to pay the costs of this matter or to give security therefore; and as the natural man, I believe I am entitled to redress;

1: for the last 12 months, I have had no [0.00 dollars] monthly income due to my current state of incarceration;

- I have no spouse

- I do not receive any monies from any employment, self-employment, rental income, interests and dividends, gifts, alimony, child support, retirement, disability, unemployment or public assistance;

2: last employer:

5: no one owes me any monies or dues;

6: I have a daughter, age 6, "A.T.H.", who depends on me for support, care, security etc.;

7: I have no monthly expenses at this time;

8: when i am released back into my tribe, i do expect changes to my monthly income, for i will be able to work and teach once again;

9: i do not plan on paying for any counsel, yet i will request for tribal counsel [if needed]

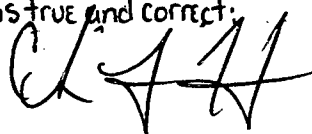
10: i can not prepay, or give security therefore, for i have been held captive for over 18⁺ months, and i have lost my home [with all my real property and valueables], and my vehicle due to the fact i could not work to support my household. i have given all that i have to my tribal nationals and my Clan mother so that my burden put on them [my daughter] can be easier, while i fight this case; i am a common hard-working indian [and a Tribal Chief], who takes care of his home and tribe, always upholding the Great Law of Peace Wampums, the Constitution, Bill of Rights, and our Cherokee Treaties, never to step outside or defy any law, as i am required to be honorable at all times;

i say now, i declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
