I am counsel of record for Respondent State of Washington in the above-captioned case. The Court has called for a response to the petition for certiorari and set the deadline for the Brief In Opposition as January 22, 2024. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, Washington requests a 30-day extension to file a brief in opposition, to February 21, 2024. Counsel for Petitioner does not object to this request.

The State's small team of attorneys that work on U.S. Supreme Court matters will be extremely busy with preparing for significant oral arguments in mid-January in the Washington Supreme Court and supervising and drafting briefing in several cases at the Washington Supreme Court during the next few months. The holiday season will also create difficulties as attorneys and staff have scheduled leave and childcare responsibilities. The extension will also allow time to incorporate a response, if necessary, to the amicus brief filed in support of the petition.

We do not believe that the extension will prejudice any party. The extension will still allow this Court to consider the petition well before the summer recess.
