

COME WORD SECOND SURGERY PLAINWORTH STILL HAD A ILEOSTOMY POUCH WHEN PLAINWORTH COME BACK FROM SURGERY BACK TO EAST WAK RESIDUAL UNIT NURSE DAVIS INDICATE PLAINWORTH M BOUL COULD NOT HAVE ILEOSTOMY SUPPLIES. THAT WAS NEEDED TO STOP LEAK'S WHAT MADE PLAINWORTH SKIN IRRITATION AROUND THE STOMA AND PAIN AND STRESS PLAINWORTH LEAK FOR OVER A MONTH EVERY DAY ALL TO THE POINT THE ILEOSTOMY POUCH START ON. 80% OF THE TIME PLAINWORTH HAD INTESTINE IN MY HAND


