I am counsel for the respondent, Westside Donut Huntington Ventures LLC ("respondent"). Petitioner filed their petition for a writ of certiorari on December 15, 2023. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, respondent respectfully requested an extension of time to file a response which was granted to and including February 20, 2024.

Respondent hereby respectfully requests a second extension of time to file a response to petitioner's writ of certiorari. Good cause exists for the requested extension as I am presently pending bar admission to the United States Supreme Court. Since respondent's last request for an adjournment, my application for admission was overnighted to the Supreme Court of the U.S., Admissions Office on February 2, 2024. Accordingly, respondent's respectfully requests that the time for filing a response be extended up to and including **March 21, 2024**.

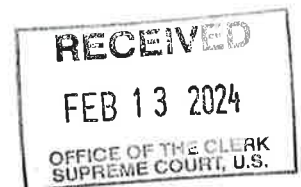
