**PETITION FOR REHEARING**

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Pursuant to Rule 44 of this Court, this ProSe Petitioner, respectfully petitions for rehearing— of the decision denying the motion to precede *informa pauperis*—before a full member Court.

1. This case does not involve a challenge by the Respondents, [Moreover, this Petitioner is not in receipt of the Respondent's Waiver or a Brief in Opposition; this Petitioner, nevertheless, a Reply to Brief in Opposition was submitted.]
2. Research shows it is rare to be granted a rehearing. However, when there are extenuating circumstances, rehearing is likely.

*[R]ehearing petitions have been granted in the past where the prior decision*

*was by an equally divided Court and it appeared likely that upon rearguement a majority one way or the other might be mustered" ...a small number of cases in which a full Bench can rehear a case decided by an equal division probably amounts to the largest class of cases in which a petition for rehearing after decision on the merits has any chance of success. United States of America v State of Texas, Supreme Court of the United States, 2015.*

3. Extenuating circumstances is bedrock in this case.

a. This Petitioner is of an indigent status because of her attempt to protect fellow Americans, as stated in my response to Question 12 of the *Affidavit in the Support of Motion for Leave to Proceed Informa Pauperis* (dated April 20, 2023):

**12. Provide any other information that will help explain why you cannot pay the costs of this case.**

Currently, I live in a Homeless Shelter. Due to the targeting I have been experiencing since 2017, I exited Nursing (direct patient care) in an attempt to keep the public safe. Because of this, my finances have been severely limited; I just re-entered Nursing because the government has been made aware of the targeting and I doubt the perpetrators will attempt to hurt patients now that the targeting has been made known. However, the financial targeting against me continues (overcharging premiums, etc). I NEED HELP PLEASE. PLEASE NOTIFY THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE.

b. This Petitioner is ProSe not by choice, but by necessity due to circumstances as outlined in the December 13, 2023 Writ of Certiorari to the District Court of South Carolina (Case No. 23-1176):

July 18, 2021, 02:39 PM email correspondence sent to two attorneys and an attorney representative:

Good Afternoon All. Attorney [redacted], everything provided is in the record. I have been saying the same thing since the erroneous affidavit was filed in November; these errors continue to occur. We have had major unnecessary setbacks that would have never occurred if I was included in the litigation process, and given appropriate time to review and make comments, as was the case before the abrupt changes in attorneys.

Yes [redacted], I understand Attorney [redacted] is an attorney at your law firm. However, I am not included in the construction of documents, as I have requested NUMEROUS times. Furthermore, I receive documents after they are submitted; this has to stop please as it is KILLING our case. Remember, I reviewed our case file when Attorney [redacted] was with us, so I know what we have (let alone having lived it).

I have included 2/15/24 phone call log and returned 1/17/24 request for the update on Case # 23-6581. I am awaiting a response from the Clerk of Court. I have submitted a Brief with the temporary Appeal and a Motion to Block a Chapter 13 with the court documents have been filed. Thank you.

[NOTE: To clarify, the last phone calls made to the Clerk of Court offices are as noted in previous letters. No recent calls have been made.] Also, as of earlier this week I noted that the documents referenced above were not being filed. I enquired per the written notification from Clerk of Court Harris and his Assistant Higgins that all documents would be made public. Please advise. In addition, please advise why the date of October 2, 2023 is listed as the decision date.

The Court denies each of the following motions for leave to file:

The motion of petitioner for leave to file a "Petition for a Writ of Certiorari" (Petition) is denied. Petitioner's Petition was filed April 18, 2023, which is outside the time for filing a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari, as provided by Rule 10, Supreme Court Rules, and is therefore not in compliance with Rule 10(d) of the Rules of this Court.

Dear Your Honor Wood (Your Honor Scott Harris.):

Attached is my petition for a Writ of Certiorari to US Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit. NOTE: This petition is in response to the judgment entered by Court of Appeals on October 2, 2023, not the judgment the Supreme Court entered for different, yet related case on the same day.

In respect of the persons and entities involved, I petition the Court to consider keeping this petition under seal. [I am willing to submit a Motion to Seal, if required, as there are many people/companies involved and I confident a federal investigation will ensue.]

Due to the continual terrorist activity, including the recent suspected murderous attempt against my life, I am again requesting Department of Justice notification, with witness protection initiated please. The terrorists are relentless; for instance, on October 20, 2023, I received a threatening voicemail from phone 8039897684 demanding if not called that day—regarding stated ID# PISEZC113289176—then other legal pursuits would be taken, including garnishments. When I called, no human being answered, only an automated recording regarding debt collection, which did not identify the business. These terrorists will not stop without force. I am calling on my country to help me, please.

NOTE: Due to the nature and severity of my circumstances, my Affidavit or Declaration in support of Motion for Leave to Proceed in Forma Pauperis, remains dated April 20, 2023. The suspected terroristic, murderous attempt (which was made to look like an accident) did reduce my monetary reserves by thousands. NOTE 2: The expedited, legal pursuit by Westgate Resorts reduced my reserves by over \$4000. NOTE 3: I opened an addition savings account; and I received a tax refund of \$3697.96 in June 2023. NOTE 4: I remain housed in a Homeless Shelter. NOTE 5: My gainful employment workload has been reduced due to the severity and subsequent effects of my current circumstances, including the terroristic targeting I continue to suffer through, coupled with case-related occurrences/requirements.

Do know, Donna Washington Farmer informed me today that she, too, continues to experience targeting (i.e. terrorism). Moreover, the "accidental" death of her son last year is quite suspicious; an investigation is requested as I believe the terrorists are responsible for Kristopher's death (he was a father of three young children, a husband, and Donna's son.). Again, I am humbly requesting expedited processing of this petition and witness protection, please. Immediate assistance against terrorism is requested.

Included with the received documents from the Supreme Court was the Supreme Court Letter dated November 29, 2023 (unsigned but with Laurie Wood name printed at the end). This letter referenced the Supreme Court October 2, 2023 denial to seal documents in the **Writ of Certiorari to US District Court of South Carolina**. I following questions remain unanswered:

1. Am I permitted to conceal my private information (residential address, personal account information, etc)?
2. Am I permitted to conceal the other targeted person name, including the deceased?
3. Does the Supreme Court want all persons and businesses names related to the requested sanctions specifically named in the corrected petition?
4. What is the due date for this corrected petition?

Also included in the Priority Mail box received from the Supreme Court [USPS tracking# 9205590245038800000294049, dated December 1, 2023, \$19.90 postage paid] was the Supreme Court Letter dated November 30, 2023 (letter signed by Your Honor Clayton R. Higgins) related to the **Writ of Certiorari to US Appeals Court for the Fourth Circuit**. I have the following questions:

The petition—mailed October 23, 2023 and received at the Supreme Court on October 24, 2023 as per USPS tracking information—did not include a motion to unseal as was indicated in the Supreme Court letter signed by Your Honor Clayton R. Higgins. As I discussed in my accompanying letter, dated October 22, 2023, the **Writ of Certiorari to US Court of Appeals is different from the Writ of Certiorari to the District Court of South Carolina**. Yes, I understand that I have ninety (90 days) from the October 2, 2023 issued Opinion—that is, until December 30, 2023—to submit the **Writ of Certiorari to US Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit**. However, since the **Writ of Certiorari** was already submitted and received by the Supreme Court on October 23, 2023—as indicated by the US Supreme Court stamped on the one copy returned to me—why was it not placed on the docket and what caused an over thirty (30) day delay in me being notified of requested corrections? [NOTE: There is a discrepancy between USPS reported delivery date of October 24, 2023 and the October 23, 2023 receipt date stamp by the Supreme Court. Regardless, there is evidence of at least one Writ of Certiorari to US Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit being received by the Supreme Court well over 30 days ago—the other ten (10) petitions remain unaccounted for. Again, only one copy of the **Writ of Certiorari to US Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit** was received from the December 1, 2023 mailed Priority box from the Supreme Court, in which I was personally in receipt of the mail on December 5, 2023]. Again, the Motion to Unseal Documents was NOT included with the **Writ of Certiorari to US Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit** [this can be verified with the October 26, 2023 filed copy at Lexington County Courthouse. Here is a copy of Lexington County Courthouse October 26, 2023 file stamp on the Motion for Leave to Proceed in Forma Pauperis (has three Courts, including US Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit as the last Court who granted leave):

NOTE 4: I remain housed in a Homeless Shelter. Note 6: I recently took out a loan from a 401k account associated with my present employer; the beginning balance was under \$5000. [It appears I inadvertently left this 401K off of the Affidavit or Declaration in support of Motion for Leave to Proceed in Forma Pauperis in all Courts.]. NOTE 7: On question 2 of the Informa Pauperis Affidavit (signed April 20, 2023) I am questioning the accuracy of the reported gross monthly amounts I reported for Salsaritas, Chicken Salad Chick, and Shella's Helping Hands. Here are the W2 annual amounts reported to the IRS: Salsarita's, Chicken Salad Chick, and Shella's Helping Hands \$1006.23 for 2020 tax year; 2022 tax year: 3781.04 (Chicken salad chick), 1495.80 (Lexington Salsaritas, NOTE: Live paychecks \$87.70 (10/10/22), 97.50 (10/18/22), 90.30 (10/19/22), 427.30 (10/29/22), 485.94 (12/14/22), 170.00 (12/21/22) should already be included in the W2 total from Lexington Salsaritas).

f. As is stated in the April 1, 2024 *Emergency Application for Stay of Petitioner to Pay Docketing Fee and Submit a Petition in compliance with Rule 33.1 by April 15, 2024:*

*The continual acts of terrorism, have taken a toll on my health and I remain under the care of a medical professional. Thus, adjustments had to be made that negatively affected my income. Therefore, beginning in December 2023, I started receiving social service assistance for food (SNAP); and more recently health insurance (Medicaid), while continuing my residence at a homeless shelter. Below is verification as of March 31, 2024:*


The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above entitled case was filed on November 21, 2023 and placed on the docket January 26, 2024 as No. 23-6591.

A form is enclosed for notifying opposing counsel that the case was docketed.

In addition, the docketed Writ of Certiorari was initially submitted on October 22, 2024 (as noted in the same-dated letter above); with the current docketed version signed December 20, 2023 being submitted on December 26, 2023; thus the stamped file date of November 21, 2023 is moot. Therefore, all Supreme Court submissions from this Petitioner, including the motions to remove identified Court Officials and Recusal, were filed because of the suspected intentional blocks to justice *that continue to occur*, not because of maliciousness. God will take care of any and all cruelty. Moreover, this Petitioner has seen

and heard the cries of the injured; and the laws of God and the United States compel me to speak what others are unable to speak—there is active terrorism occurring in our land, hence the reason for this petition. For example, I am concerned that my compliance to this Court's October 2, 2023 order to unseal documents has contributed to the targeting. On March 29, 2024, I received yet another call threatening legal action against someone named Erica. The call came from 4022003586, mandating that I call 8889182598 to prevent additional action including filing a lawsuit. I called 4022003586 (named Central Processing) and notified the female representative that this persistent harassment is being reported. The representative stated Erica's name without me having to provide the case number and stated my number would be removed; I find that suspicious. My returned call went to voicemail, in which I requested to stop calling my number with names of people I do not know. Here is verification of the calls:



Despite many unanswered questions, it appears an updated *informa pauperis* application is warranted and is thus attached. This Court should grant rehearing to provide for a decision by the Court with a full complement of Members given the significance of this


case on the nation as a whole. Lives are on the line, America is at stake. This Court has the jurisdiction to help Americans win the war against home-grown terrorism.






