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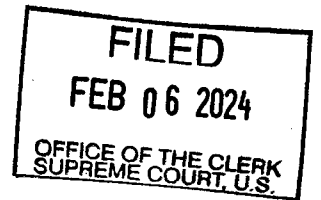

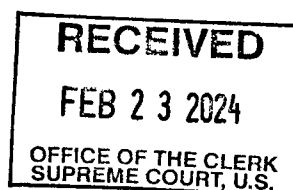


REASONS FOR GRANTING THE PETITION

That this was a matter outside of my own actions and control and I ask that this late appeal be excused or pardoned as it would otherwise been timely filed as I was transferred to another facility and was unable to get my legal materials from correctional staff for three weeks after my transfer in which I only had 30 days to file which the other weeks delay was contributed to awaiting a mail out and that being delayed by the legal library at that institution by taking the law library staff a whole week to show up for a mail out.
