

The Los Angeles County Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) previously received your request to review the submission of your identifying information to the California Department of Justice (DOJ) Child Abuse Central Index (CACI). Following a review of the information available, including your legal file, your request cannot be accepted or processed, as the information that was used to report your identifying information to the CACI Database was previously adjudicated in Juvenile Dependency Court in Department 405. California Department of Social Services (CDSS) Manual of Policies and Procedures (MPP) Division 31-021.31, No Grievance Review Hearing shall be required when a court of competent jurisdiction has determined that the suspected abuse or neglect has occurred, or when the allegation of child abuse or neglect resulting in the referral to the Child Abuse Central Index is pending, before the court. Because the allegations of abuse were determined to be true in Juvenile Dependency Court, you are ineligible for any legal relief and/or appeal of these findings. In the event that you are concerned about this information, please feel free to discuss this matter with a legal professional.
