On referral from the U.S. District Judge (ECF No. 639), a hearing on defendant's Motion to Appoint CJA Counsel and to Withdraw Counsel (ECF No. 321) was held this date before United States Magistrate Judge Donna Phillips Currault.

Defendant consented to appear by telephone.

Although Defendant indicated that he had completed and mailed the application to proceed without prepayment of fees and affidavit (AO Form 240), as ordered by this Court (ECF No. 653), the court has not yet received same.

Defendant was sworn and questioned as to his financial status based on his financial affidavit dated October 26, 2021, and information provided in his Final Presentence Investigation Report (ECF No. 224, at 21-24), and he provided sworn responses regarding the information on the AO Form 240. During questioning, Defendant explained that the assets previously reported have been sold to satisfy mortgages, debts, legal fees, and other expenses. Defendant specifically confirmed that he no longer owns the property identified in his Final Presentence Investigation Report.

For reasons stated on the record,

IT IS ORDERED that the Motion to Appoint CJA Counsel and to Withdraw

Counsel is **GRANTED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Castaing be removed as counsel of record upon enrollment of CJA counsel appointed to represent the defendant in the trial proceedings and on appeal.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the record be supplemented with defendant's application to proceed without prepayment of fees and affidavit (AO Form 240) upon receipt of same.

The defendant remains remanded to the custody of the U.S. Marshal.
